Said property is the same conveyed to Compac Storage, Inc. by M. F. Woodward by Deed dated June 15, 1987, being recorded in said office in Deed Book 1297 at Page 456.

The above described properties is hereinafter referred to as "Property", or "Owners Property".

- 2. That the Defendant, CISSON CONSTRUCTION, INC., is the Contractor, and the Defendant, NATIONAL CONSTRUCTION RESOURCES, a subcontractor providing material, labor and services in connection with improvements made to Owners Property described in paragraph l.
- 3. The last furnishing of materials as set out herein by Plaintiff, was delivered to the Owners Property described in paragraph 1, on or about the 29th day of April, 1988, the same being less than 90 days from the within date.
