

the unpaid balance owed on the account at the rate of 18% per annum. I find and conclude from the testimony and evidence presented that there is presently a balance due and owing on this account in the sum of Sixteen Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Five and 79/100 (\$16,165.79) Dollars. The Plaintiff is entitled to judgment against the Defendant, Dave W. Awde, individually and d/b/a Passive Solar Group of Greenville/Audae Homes, in this amount.

Further, the Plaintiff is entitled to the attorney's fees that it has incurred in connection with this action. Pursuant to the terms of the attorney fee agreement between the Plaintiff and its attorney, the Plaintiff has agreed to representation by its attorney on the basis of an hourly rate of Eighty-Five (\$85.00) Dollars per hour, plus actual costs incurred. The Plaintiff's attorney has submitted an Affidavit for Attorney's Fees reflecting that he has expended fifteen and one-half (15.5) hours in preparation for the trial of this case through Thursday, September 8, 1988. Additionally, the Plaintiff's attorney was present at the hearing in this matter for approximately one and one-half (1.5) hours on Friday, September 9, 1988. Further, the Plaintiff's attorney has incurred additional time in preparing a proposed Order at my request. As a result, I find that the Plaintiff's attorney has expended at least nineteen (19) hours in connection with the representation of the Plaintiff's interests in this matter. Accordingly, I find and conclude that the Plaintiff is entitled to an award of attorney's fees in this matter in the sum of One Thousand Six Hundred Fifteen (\$1,615.00)
