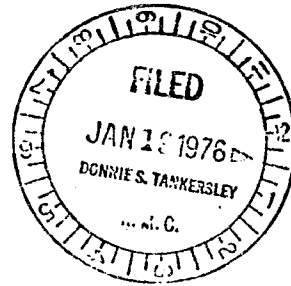

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that pursuant to the provisions of Section 96, Subsection d, of Act No. 368 of the Acts of the General Assembly of South Carolina for 1953, and any amendments thereto, the South Carolina Mental Health Commission claims and has a lien from the 19th day of September, 1970, upon all of the real and personal property of Frances M.
