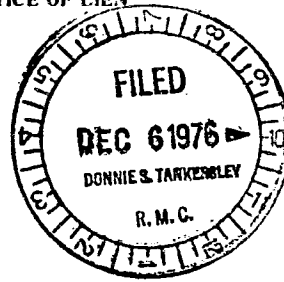

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that pursuant to the provisions of Section 96, Subsection d, of Act No. 368 of the Acts of the General Assembly of South Carolina for 1953, and any amendments thereto, the South Carolina Mental Health Commission claims and has a lien from the 14th day of March 1973, upon all of the real and personal property of Frances Hill for the expense incurred by the State of South Carolina in furnishing medical care and maintenance in a State mental health facility to the said Frances Hill the amount of said expense to the State as of the date hereof being \$ 832.00.
