until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of one per cent 10% besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to

the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. M. Batt, his heirs and assigns,

all that piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being situate on the south east side of Butler Avenue in Ward One of the City of Greenville, in said County and State, and being the same lot of land conveyed to Mr. E. A. Herrick by Mr. Mcintosh by deed recorded in Book 37 at page 191, and by the said Mr. E. A. Herrick devised to Elizabeth A. A. and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake 150 feet from the corner of Hampton Avenue and Butler Avenue and running thence along Butler Avenue S. 18° W. 50 feet to a stake; the corner of what was formerly C. A. Herrick's lot; thence with Herrick's line S. 64 1/4 E. 156 feet to F. A. Walter's corner; thence with F. A. Walter's line N. 18 E. 50 feet to Richardson's line; thence N. 64 1/4 W. 156 feet to the beginning corner.
