with interest thereon from the day of October 1919 at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid

and paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent (10%)

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said R. S. McSwain, her heirs and assigns

all that piece, parcel or lot of land  
situate, lying and being just outside the inner  
limits of the City of Greenville, South  
Carolina, being known and designated as Lot  
# 24 on plat of Suburban Land Company of  
what is known as Sans Souci Villa, and  
having according to said plat the following  
metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at  
an iron pin on west side of Brockman  
avenue, joint corners of Lots Nos. 24 and  
25 - and running thence north with line of  
Lot # 25 N. 57-25 West 169 feet to an iron pin  
thence S. 24-42 W. 84 feet to corner of Lots Nos.  
23 and 24; thence with line of Lot No. 23 S.  
57-25 E. 192 feet to iron pin on Brockman  
avenue; thence N. 10-30 E. 91 feet to beginning
