with interest thereon from date at the rate Seven per cent per annum to be
computed and paid immediately

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of the like cost of the
attorney due in said State besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings, of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said J. A. Park

all that certain lot of land situate, lying and
being in the County and State aforesaid, and
being known as No. 4 in Block #4, as shown
on Plat, recorded in Deed Book S.P.S., page 115,
and lying on the south side of Brooks Boulevard
Boulevard and having the following metes
and bounds to-wit: beginning at the corner
of lot #5; thence with Brooks Boulevard
39.37 ft. forty-nine (49) feet and ecedent (11)
inches to corner of lot #9; thence with the
line of lot #9 8.50 ft. one hundred and
seventy nine (179) feet to corner of lot #9
and 6; thence with the line of lot #6 39.55 ft. fifty (50) feet to corner lot #6
and 5; thence with line of lot #5 200 ft. one hundred
and seventy eight (178) feet and ecedent (11)
