WHEREAS, I, Jesse McKinney, the said Jesse McKinney
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

Mamie Poole
in the full and just sum of Four Hundred and Twenty-Five Dollars (\$425.00)
Dollars, to be paid on or before May 1, 1919

with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent of the
amount due upon said note besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Jesse McKinney
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mamie Poole
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said Jesse McKinney
(in hand paid and truly paid by the said Mamie Poole

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said Mamie Poole,

this mortgage satisfied in full
this 29 day of Oct 1919
all that certain tract of land situate in Paris
Mountain Township, County and State aforesaid,
known as tract # 3 on the plat of survey
of the land of the estate of Gabriel Thompson,
deceased, made by W. D. Hester, Surveyor, on
the 12th day of November, 1910, containing fifteen
(15) acres, more or less, and having the following
metes and bounds, to-wit: beginning on a
stone in fork of branch, and running thence
S. 85 E. 3.40 to stone 477M; thence N. 21 E. 21.50 to
stone on north side of branch; thence down
branch as the line 27.00 to stone on branch
at fork; thence up branch as the line 15.30 to
fork of branch, the beginning corner, said being
the same tract of land conveyed to me by
S. W. Gray, Master, by deed dated March, 1911,
