WHEREAS, L. M. Hall the said L. M. Hall

even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Twenty Dollars and no/100
Dollars, to be paid to Planters Savings Bank

with interest thereon from the 1st day of January 1919 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid quarterly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That L. M. Hall the said L. M. Hall
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Planters Savings Bank

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said L. M. Hall

in hand well and truly paid by the said Planters Savings Bank
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said Planters Savings Bank, All that

certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate
lying and being in Greenville County and State
aforesaid near Pelham Mills, and having the
following meters and bounds to-wit: beginning
on a stone L. J. Hutchings corner and running
thence N. 62 E. 10.70 to a stone by dogwood; thence
S. 66 1/2 E. 15.83 to an iron pin in road leading
to Green; thence S. 50 E. 4.25 to stone in vines;
thence S. 41 W. 12.10 to stone near bridge; thence
N. 55 W. 3.50 to an iron pin in road; thence N. 1.37
to an iron pin in ditch; thence S. 61 W. 2.58 to
a spring; thence with meanderings of the
spring branch as the line to a cedar in
branch 34; thence N. 11 1/4 E. 26.08 to the beginning
