Heirs and Assigns, from and against us and our Heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns, and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.

And the said mortgagor agree to insure the house and buildings on said lot in a sum not less than Eight Hundred

800.00 Dollars (in a company or companies satisfactory to the mortgagee), and keep the same insured from loss or damage by fire, and assign the policy of insurance to the said mortgagee, and that in the event that the mortgagor shall at any time fail to do so, then the said mortgagee may cause the same to be insured in their name, and reimburse himself

And if at any time any part of said debt, or interest thereon, be past due and unpaid 1 hereby assign the rents and profits

PROVIDED ALWAYS, NEVERTHELESS, and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these Presents, that if we the mortgagors do and shall well and truly pay, or cause to be paid, unto the said mortgagee the said debt or sum of money aforesaid, with interest thereon, if the same be due, according to the true intent and meaning of the said note, then this deed of bargain and sale shall cease, determine, and be utterly null and void; otherwise it shall remain in full force and virtue.
