I, John B. Davis

SEND GREETING: aforsaid

WHEREAS, I, the said John B. Davis of the County and State
in and by certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to J. A. Park

in the full and just sum of One thousand dollars
Dollars, to be paid one year from date

with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight
computed and paid annually per cent. per annum to be

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten percent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That John B. Davis

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said J. A. Park

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

John B. Davis

in hand well and truly paid by the said J. A. Park.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said J. A. Park all that certain piece parcel

land tract of land situate lying and being in the County
of Greenville, and in the State aforesaid, beginning in
the center of Long Branch, being a water oak corner and
running thence S. 19 1/2 W. 11.22 to stone 3x0 m; thence N. 54 E.
17.00 to a pine 3x0 m; thence N. 2 1/2 W. 45.00 to stone 3x2 m; thence
78 1/2 W. 17.00 to Long Branch thence down Long Branch to the
beginning corner containing fifty six (56) acres more or less.
Being the land conveyed to me by Henry Mosely by deed dated
July 14 - 1903 recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County
in Deed Book Jff page 670

Also that other tract of land situate in the County
and State aforesaid adjoining the tract of land just

Seventy (70) acres more or less conveyed by Rosa E. D. Dickson
to Henry Mosely on Jan. 9th 1895 and by him to me on
