computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

10% of amount due

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said Thomas Sloan, All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land

situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, being known as Tract No. 3
on plat of the Wynn property as made by W.A. Hester, Surveyor, on August 21st, 1918
the plat being recorded in plat book E., page 112, and having the following metes and
bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on the road to the Artillery Range, corner of Edwards
land and running thence S. 9-1/2 E. 24.10 to a post-oak X30m; thence N. 64-40 E. 9.15 to
a post-oak stump om; thence N. 80-1/4 E. 10.85 to a stone om, corner of tract No. 4; thence
N. 15 W. 16.30 to iron pin on road to Edwards Mill; thence with said Road N. 36-1/2 E.
7.85 to a Pinestump at the cross roads; thence S. 86 W. 19.00 following Artillery Range
Road; thence S. 5-1/2 W. 5.08 along said road to the beginning corner. This tract of land
