SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Ed. Harrison
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, and well and truly indebted to

Mrs. Bessie H. Atkinson
in the full and just sum of one hundred and twenty-five
Dollars, to be paid one year after date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of twenty-five dollars

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Ed. Harrison and

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said Bessie H. Atkinson

That piece, parcel or lot of land in the County
and State aforesaid in Greenville Township and in
what is known as "Freetown" and being the same
lot that was conveyed to me by Bessie Edens, by two
deeds, one dated - day of September 1913 and one
dated Mar-1, 1915 in order to correct description in
the former deed. The lot hereby mortgaged has the
following metes and bounds according to survey made
by W. D. Neves: Beginning at a stone 3x on J. M. Harris
line, and running thence N. 13-35 W. eighty eight
feet to an iron pin; thence N. 82 W. one hundred and
forty one feet to an iron pin on west side of an
alley, thence with the west side of alley S. 13-35
E. eighty feet to an iron pin 3x of J. M. Harris
place thence S. 82 E. one hundred and forty one feet
to the beginning corner, and containing one fourth
of an acre more or less, as per plat by W. D. Neves.
