with interest thereon from time of payment at the rate of 6 per cent. per annum to be

computed and paid until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or

interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may

sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten percent per annum

Beginning on the north side of Mountain View Avenue 483 8/10 feet from Cuthbert Road, corner of lot 5, and running thence with Mountain View Avenue 805.88 feet; thence N. 25° W. 164 5/10 feet to an alley; thence with Alley N. 25° W. 88 feet to corner of lot 5; thence with line of lot 5 N. 25° W. 164 5/10 feet to the beginning corner, and being a part of lot 6 Block A Bust Bridge, a plat of which is recorded in the R. M. & Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "B" at page 18.
