with interest thereon from the date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said J. W. Norwood, his heirs and assigns

All that certain piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying
and being in Greenville City, Greenville County, South
Carolina, on the west side of River Street, adjoining
lot formerly owned by Arthur E. Gradick. Beginning
at a stake in the southeast corner of said Arthur
E. Gradick lot, and running thence with said lot N. 62 ³/₄
W. one hundred and seventy feet to a stake on line
of lot no. 5, thence N. 27 ¹/₄ E. Seventy feet to the right of
Way of Railway Company, thence S. 62 E. One hundred
and seventy three feet to a stake on River Street,
thence with River Street S. 27 ¹/₄ W. Sixty-four feet
to the beginning corner, being lot no. 3 on a survey
of J. W. Southern July 1897, and being the same lot
