at and before the signing of these Presents, the property hereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. H. Moore and J. N. Bell, all that tract of land situate in the County and State and County aforesaid about three miles from Greenville Court House, containing forty-two and ten one-hundredths (42.10) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the center of Rutherford Road and running thence S. 37.10 E. 341 ft to a large white oak; thence S. 15.45 E. 1009.5 ft to a stake by wild cherry; thence S. 0.45 E. 813. feet to a poplar tree; thence S. 21.18 E. 1353 ft to a stake in center of Pickland Creek; thence up said Creek with the center as per line N. 54.23 W. 87.8.4 N. 75.48 W. 222.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 13.53 E. 617.4 ft to an iron pin by apple tree, thence N. 23.57 E. 300 feet to a stake in Rutherford Road, thence N. 46.10 E. 45.7 ft with Rutherford Road to the beginning as per plat made by T. E. Dalton, November 1915 and being the same tract of land conveyed to us by W. F. Blue and C. L. Cleveland by deed dated 23rd June 1919 to be recorded; also, all that tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid on Pickland Creek and on Rutherford Road about three miles from Greenville Court house, being a part of the tract of land conveyed to William Chaplin to A. S. Cole by deed dated November 3, 1873 and recorded in Vol F. F. Page 142 R. M. Co. Office for Greenville County, containing five (5) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning in an apple tree corner 360 W. H. Davis' line running thence S. 24.23 E. 302.3 to a peg in center of road and W. H. Davis' line; thence down road S. 56.00 W. 342.7 ft to peg in road; thence S. 43.30 E. 042.5 to iron pin on W. H. Davis' line; thence N. 13.45 E. 498.7 to beginning, as per plat made by R. F. & L. L. September 14, 1911. Also all that tract of land adjoining above, containing 2.2 acres, more or less, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at iron pin on Rutherford Road, corner of Jane & "Aunt" Ladd's land, and running thence with said S. 43.30 E. 042.5 ft to an iron pin; thence S. 13.45 E. 352 ft to a stake; thence N. 24.43 W. 881.8 feet to beginning, being triangular in shape, and being the same tracts of land conveyed to us by the executors and the heirs at law of Jane & R.
