date, Five hundred (\$500.00) two years from date, and  
Nine hundred (\$900.00) Dollars three years from date.

with interest thereon from date of note at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be

computed and paid annually.

.....unpaid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Five percent premium

.....besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to John Park, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John Park

all that piece, parcel, lot and tract of land lying and being in said year the Town of Marietta, in the County and State aforesaid, containing five and one fourth acres, more or less, and described by metes and bounds as follows: Beginning on a road near the Pumpkin Town Road, once Walker's corner; thence running about due east 1.30 to a stake; thence N. 22 E. with the Jones Gap Road 150 to a stake; thence N. 81 W. 2.00 to a stake; thence N. 61 E. 3.00 to a stake; thence N. 87 W. 10.00 to a stake; thence S. 52 W. 2.15 to a stake S. 52 E. 1.80 to a stake; thence about due east 3.37 to the beginning compassing the same lot of land this day by Willm. Linn Bishop; Also all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, near the village of Marietta, and containing Forty-one and one-fourth 4.25 acres, being the same tract of land which was conveyed to William M. Freeman by Joab Penford by deed of date 14th September 1829, in R. L. Office Vol. 1532 and having the following lines, metes and bounds to wit: Beginning on a stone (now or formerly R. C. Foster's corner), and running thence S. 80 3/4 W. 4.35 to a stake in said R. C. Foster's line; thence N. 70 1/4 W. 10.83 to a stone; thence N. 11 3/4 E. 24.93 to a stone in John Guest's line; thence S. 88 1/2 E. 17.46 to a stone with John Guest's line to the Old Gap Creek Road; thence S. 20 1/2 W. 4.72 to a stone in John Guest's line and thence S. 14 E. 23.80 with the Old Gap Creek Road to the beginning and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by J. H. Forrest, by deed dated January 15th, 1918, and recorded in R. L. Office for Greenville County, in Vol 51 page 45.
