until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of the amount due and all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being made as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Susan O. Truille and her heirs and assigns,

forever, all and singular that certain piece, parcel lot or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State aforesaid, near the incorporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot 410.10 of Block E 2 of property of O. P. Truille, deceased, as shown on plat of said property recorded in the Register of Deed's Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at page 176. Said lot has the following described metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin corner of Prentiss Avenue and Lawson Street, thence N. 44.33 W. one hundred and eighty feet to an alley; thence with said alley N. 45.57 E. sixty five feet to an iron pin corner of lot 410.8, thence along line of lot 410.8 A. 44.33 E. one hundred and eighty feet to an iron pin on said Prentiss Avenue, thence with said Prentiss Avenue S. 45.57 W. fifty-five feet to the beginning.
