paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of six percent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the said H. E. T. Sell

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Poinsett Realty Company

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to the said

H. E. T. Sell, in hand well and truly paid by the said Poinsett Realty Company

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being situate on the south side of Crescent Avenue, in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid and being known and designated as "Upon the plat of Crescent Terrace" as lot No. 31, said plat being recorded in the office of R. M. L. Greenville County in Plat Book 8 at page 137, said lot beginning at a point on Crescent Avenue 40 feet from the lands now belonging to S. K. Tindall and running thence S. 5° 41' E. 250 feet to lot No. 33 on said plat; thence N. 84° 40' E. 840 feet to corner of lot No. 32; thence N. 2° 26' E. 250.4 feet to Crescent Avenue; thence along Crescent Avenue S. 84° 40' E. 98.3 feet to beginning corner on Crescent Avenue, on the east side of lot No. 32, on the south by lot No. 33 and on the west by lot No. 30 and being a portion of the lands conveyed to the Poinsett Realty Company by S. K. Tindall by her deed dated June 25th, 1918 and being recorded in the office of the R. M. L. Greenville County in Book 54 at page 61, reference being herein made to the aforesaid plat and deed for a more particular and definite description of the said lot of land, and this obligation is made to secure a balance due upon the purchase price of the above lot of land.

It is understood and agreed that this is a first mortgage upon the above described land.
