WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Twenty Five Hundred (2,500.00) Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of six eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Being known and designated as lot. no 8 in the West Perry subdivision of fourteen acres of land on the Buncombe Road two miles north of the city of Greenville, known as Sans Souci Park, as per plat recorded in the office R. M. C. for Greenville County, in Plat Book 16, at page 158, having the following lines, bearings and distances:-  
Beginning at a stake on the eastern edge of Perry Road 416 feet from the southeastern corner of McBall street at its intersection with said road and running thence with said Perry Road S. 17-45 W. 65 feet; thence with said road S. 14-50 W. 65 feet to stake; thence S. 4-26 E. 210 feet to stake; thence N. 17-45 W. 130 feet to stake; thence N. 74-26 W. 210 feet to the beginning corner.

This being the same lot conveyed to Augusta C. Squier by James M. Jordan, Jr. by deed dated Sept. 28th - 1918 and not yet recorded; and conveyed to said Jordan by Carolina Loan & Trust Co. by deed recorded in the office R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book 32 at page 285, reference being hereto made to the two said deeds and the plat aforesaid for a more particular description of said lot.
