WITNESSETH, that the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Five Thousand Eight Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Situate on the west side of Westfield Street, in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, being lot no. 1 in a subdivision of the lot of land conveyed to the said James B. League by Kate Hyde Sloan, by deed dated the 1st day of May 1912 and recorded in Vol. 76 page 341; the lot hereby conveyed having the following courses and distances to-wit: Beginning at the corner of the Davis lot at an iron pin on Westfield, and running thence along the line of that lot N. 69-15 W. 174.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 21 W. 48.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 69-15 E. 174.5 feet to an iron pin on Westfield street, thence along Westfield Street N. 21 E. 48.6 feet to the beginning corner.
