WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Three Thousand Full Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of six eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece or parcel of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that ~~piece~~ land situate on the East side of David Street in the City and County of Greenville South Carolina, and described as follows, Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of David Street, which pin is the North west of the lot owned by L. S. Dard and running thence N. 24.15 W. 90 feet with David Street to an iron pipe at the corner of David Street and a twenty foot alley, which belongs to the City; thence with said alley N. 89.8 E. 171.7 feet to an iron pipe which is the corner of C. A. Dard's property; thence running with his line S. 17.4 E. 21.7 feet to an iron pipe which is the North-east corner of L. S. Dard's property; thence S. 65.45 W. 155 feet with L. S. Dard's line to the beginning corner, being the same land conveyed to me by Elizabeth H. Long, this day, deed not yet recorded.
