All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville County and State of South Carolina, said on the east side of Rowley Street in the Block North of Park Avenue, and known as lot No 2 on a resurvey of City Park made for D. B. Trauler Agt. in April 1912 by Bill H. Neely, Engineer, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Rowley Street and running thence S 76.30 & one hundred sixty-six and eight tenths (166.8) feet along the line of lot No 1 to an iron pin; thence N. 30.30 & fifty two (52) feet to an iron pin at corner of lot No 3; thence N 76.30 & one hundred and seventy six and six tenths (176.6) feet along the line of lot No 3 to an iron pin on Rowley Street; thence with said Rowley Street S 20-10 fifty (50) feet to the beginning corner.
