Beginning at an iron pin on Cannon Street and run thence S. 33.45 W. 145 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 55 E. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 33.45 W. 145 feet along the line of lot No. 7 to an iron pin on Cannon Street; thence N. 55 W. 60 feet along said Street to the beginning corner, and being known as lot No. 6 on a survey made for J. M. Wood by W. A. Christopher, Surveyor, Nov. 24, 1919, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by J. M. Wood.
