do hereby truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Alvin W. Foster, Administratrix*

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Garitt*

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, *on the White Horse Road about*

five miles from Greenville Court House, known as lot no. 3 in the division of the estate of Alfred Walker, as surveyed December 3rd. 1917 by W. J. Riddle, containing 13.13 acres, more or less: Beginning at an iron pile on the White Horse Road, and running thence N. 5-10 W. 37.15 to Stake; thence N. 86 1/2 W. 2.06 to Stake; thence S. 1 W. 31.58 to stake on White Horse Road, thence along said road 8.00 to the beginning.
