Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Old Spartanburg Road, about three and one-half miles from the City of Greenville, containing thirty-four and forty-two one-hundredths acres (34-42/100), more or less, and having such metes and bounds as shown by a survey and plat of the same made by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, on the 25th, of March 1919, to-wit: Commencing at an iron pin on the south side of Old Spartanburg Road, corner of Amick property; thence along the old location of said road N. 83-28 E. 808 feet to an iron pin in center of road; thence along line of Sneed property N. 5-44 W. 2155 feet to an iron pin on line of McCarter property; thence along line of McCarter property S. 81-45 W. 592 feet to an iron pipe, corner of McCarter property; thence along line of McCarter and Amick property S. 0-03 W. 2148 feet to the iron pin at the point of beginning, being the same tract of land conveyed to me this day by Mrs. Susan McGee Barksdale, by deed to be recorded.
