all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Grove*

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, *on Reedy River, containing 6 1/4 acres,*

more or less, bounded by lands of B. A. Barker, J. J. Cox and James Mc Gee, having the following courses and distances: Beginning on a Stone 3x0m on Cox's line, thence N. 66 1/2 E. 23.30 to a maple 3x0m on branch, thence down said branch N. 64 1/2 E. 13.00 to stone in branch, thence down said branch N. 19 E. 4.50 to mouth of branch at river, thence down Reedy River S. 63 E. 9.19 to bend of river, thence down river 22.50 to poplar at mouth of branch, thence up branch 4.00 to bend, thence up branch 5.00 to bend, thence up branch 3.25 to bend, thence up branch 3.50 to bend, thence up branch 9.60 to corner in branch 3x0m, thence up said branch N. 75 W. 4.00 to stone in branch, thence S. 63 W. 4.00 to Sweet gum at bridge, thence up said branch S. 44 W. 3.00 to rock in branch on Cox's and Barker's line, thence N. 21 1/2 W. 9.50 to the beginning corner, being the same tract conveyed to D.
