 any kind, reference being hereinunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I..... the said *E. P. Bushman*  
 in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the  
 payment thereof according to the terms of the said note..... and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me.....  
 in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and  
 released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Wm. G. Surrine*

 all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in..... *City of Greenville, Greenville*  
*Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, Second Ward of the City of Greenville,*

having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an  
 iron pin on the north east corner of Jackson Street and  
 Markley Alley (said point being 4 ft. north of the original  
 line of said Markley Alley) and running thence with  
 the new line of said Markley Alley (said line being 4 ft.  
 north and parallel with the old line of said Markley  
 Alley) S. by E. one hundred seventy nine and nine tenths  
 (179.9) feet to an iron pin on an eleven foot alley; thence  
 with said 11 ft. alley N. 20.30 E. one hundred eight feet  
 to an iron pin on a 16 ft. alley; thence with said 16 foot  
 alley north one hundred seventy nine (179) feet to an iron  
 pin on the E. side of Jackson Street; thence with said Jackson  
 Street 20.37 West one hundred and two feet to the begin-  
 ning corner. Bounded on the west by Jackson Street; on  
 the south by Markley Alley; on the east by an 11 ft. alley  
 and on the north by a 16 ft. alley; the location of the alleys  
 is more particularly described in an agreement between  
 Greenville Cotton Mills Co. and Sarah A. Davidson, dated  
 January 13, 1913 and recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville  
 County in Deed Book 22, page 139. The width of Markley  
 Alley, however, having subsequently been increased by  
 an agreement between Markley Realty Co. W. S. Bradley  
 and others, recorded in Register of Mental Conveyances  
 office for Greenville County in Volume 22, page 386  
 and being one of the lots of land conveyed to me by  
 Allan J. Graham by deed dated the 20th day of  
 March 1918, Volume 51, page 105.
