promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, *Will Mayer*

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Nannie C. Pinson*

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Gantt* Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, *about five miles south of Greenville*

court house, near the White Horse Road, containing 3 1/2 acres, more or less, and having the following meters and bounds: Beginning at stake on the White line and running thence N. 87 W. 6.50 to stake; thence S. 3 W. 5.38 to stake; thence S. 87 E. 6.50 to stake on Alfred Walker's line; thence N. 3 E. 5.38 to the beginning corner, being the same conveyed to me by Sarah Mayer, Mary Brown, and Eliza Vaughn by deed, dated April 19th, 1919, to be recorded.
