in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Citizens Trust Company*

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Greenville*

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying North of the City of Greenville

near the incorporate limits having the following boundaries: Beginning at an iron pin 228 feet and 7 inches from the Northwest corner of North Main Street (as laid out on Plat of Highland Terrace) and Hillcrest Drive and running thence in a Westerly direction with Hillcrest Drive 75 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot number 5; thence S. 23. 30 W. with lot number 5, 190 feet to an iron pin on an alley; thence with the alley S. 66. 30 E. 45 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot number 3; thence N. 23. 30 E. 190 feet with lot number 3 to an iron pin at the beginning corner, known as lot number 4 on our Plat recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book 6 at page 102.
