with interest from *date* at the rate of *seven* per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid annually, and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and *me* have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *me* the said *Sam R. Zimmerman and Ferris M. Williams* in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to *me* in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *John B. Marshall, all those certain lots of land situated in the State and County of Greenville, all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in aforesaid and in the City of Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as*

*lots numbers one (1) three (3), four (4), five (5), six (6), seven (7), twelve (12), thirteen (13), fourteen (14), fifteen (15), eighteen (18), nineteen (19), twenty-two (22) twenty-six (26), twenty-seven (27) and thirty (30), on a plat of Survey of lands of Sam R. Zimmerman and Ferris M. Williams, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, May 1919 recorded in the Register of Deeds Conveyance Office for State and County aforesaid in Plat Book "E" at page 132, being a part of the land conveyed to the mortgagee herein by Eliza S. Williams, by deed dated the day of 1919, recorded in the Register of Deeds Conveyance Office for State and County above named.*
