All that tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, about two and one-half miles from Greenville Court House, on what is known as Summit Drive and designated as tract No. 11 on plat recorded in Plat Book E, Page 170, Beginning at a pipe corner of tract No. 10 on Summit Drive and running thence with Summit Drive S. 24.5, 2 N. 64.3 feet to bend in said drive, thence continuing with said drive S. 62.5, 1 E. 23.2 feet to bend in said drive; thence continuing with said drive S. 34.0 E. 12.9 feet to branch or creek; thence down said branch as the line to another branch; thence up this other branch as the line to the corner of tract No. 10; thence with the line of tract No. 10 N. 73. 20 N. 560 feet to the beginning corner, containing 9.75 acres, more or less, and being the same land conveyed to us by J.
