according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me, the said Ethel B. Davis

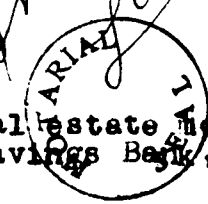
