in hand well and truly paid by the said The Bank of Commerce at and before sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, regained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Bank of Commerce, its successors and assigns

forever, the following described real estate, to-wit:  
"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in Butler Township, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, containing 30 acres and bounded by lands of Press Lipscomb, Prof. Cook and others and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on line of land of Press Lipscomb, this point being on the road leading from Laurens Road and Press Lipscomb's home, and running thence N. 27-1/2 W. 10.30 to an iron pin; thence S. 59-3/4 W. 24.50 to an iron pin on Reedy River; thence down said River as the line 2.43, more or less, to a stake; thence along the old run of River line, S. 55 E. 86 links to a point; thence continuing along said line S. 29 E. 2.00 to a point 3X; thence continuing along said line S. 65-1/2 E. 1.21 to a point 3X; thence continuing along said line S. 22-1/2 E. 2.50 to a point 3X; thence continuing along said line S. 34-1/4 E. 1.00 to a point 3x; thence continuing along said line S. 25 E. 1.50 to a point 3x; thence continuing along said line S. 38 E. 2.00 to an iron pin in line of land of Press Lipscomb; thence along Press Lipscomb's line N. 50-1/2 E. 24.25 c to iron pin at the beginning corner, as shown by plat made by W.A. Adams, Surveyor, in January 1918, and R.E. Dalton's addition thereto in 1920, and being the same land conveyed to me by T.G. Glenn by deed dated February 2, 1920, and recorded in Vol. 63, page 192, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County."
