interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
suit thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten percent on account
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Ella D. Barr, for and

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said D. W. Cochran

All that piece, parcel or tract of land, in the County
and State aforesaid, containing 5 1/2 acres or
more or less, on the North east side of the
Augusta-Road and having the following bounded
and bounded, courses and distance: Beginning
at an iron pipe on said road at corner of
the Caudle property, thence 21° 58' 30" E. 1870 feet
to iron pipe corner; thence 24° 31' E. 126 1/2 feet
to iron pipe corner on tract No. 2; thence along said
tract 21° 58' 34" N. 1806 feet to iron pipe corner and said
road; thence along said road 21° 52' 48" N. 131 feet to
the beginning corner according to plat by P. E.
Latton, dated March 1919, and we record a tract
No. 1 to said tract, and in the same land conveyed
to me by said D. W. Cochran this day of this
mortgage being given to secure the balance of
the purchase money for said tract;
