WHEREAS, I, the said Maggie Williams, in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, made to Mrs. Lavinia Mathews, well and truly indebted to me, in the full and just sum of Fifty Dollars, to be paid One year from the date

with interest thereon from the date at the rate of 8 per cent per annum to be computed and paid annually, Aug 1921,

until paid in full, interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10 per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Maggie Williams

in consideration of the said debt, sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Mrs. Lavinia Mathews according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said Mrs. Lavinia Mathews

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Lavinia Mathews her heirs and

assigne, all my interest in all that piece parcel or lot of land in the City and County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, to Logan Street in said City, beginning at an iron iron 51 + $\frac{3}{4}$ feet from the east side of Cook Street, and running thence in an Easterly direction with north side of Logan Street 51 + $\frac{3}{4}$ feet more or less to line of lot laid by W. S. Sirrine to Clark Allen; thence with line of said Allen N. 18.30 W. 100 feet to line of lot of Mrs Alice C. Ferguson; thence with her line S. 41.30 W. 51 + $\frac{3}{4}$ feet more or less to an iron iron; thence S. 18.730 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner, being same lot conveyed to Ed. Williams my late husband by W. S. Sirrine by deed dated August 23rd 1911 and recorded in R. M. C. office, Greenville County in book 10 page 100.
