in the full and just sum of Two Thousand two hundred and sixty five (\$2265.00)
Dollars, to be paid Two years after date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8% per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid Annually

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Five percent of amount
due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

J. P. Jones in hand well and truly paid by the said G. W. Williams

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said G. W. Williams his heirs and

assigns, all that certain parcel, or tract of land
lying and being in the County and State aforesaid
About 3 3/4 miles from the Court House on the south
side of the Buncombe Road. Beginning at an iron
pin at corner of Pettus lot and Parkers Land Co's
tract and running thence N. 30 E. 539 feet to an
iron pin on Hughes's line; thence with Hughes's
line N. 89.30 E. 406 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 93.7 W.
539 feet to an iron pin on Parker Land Co's line;
thence S. 89.30. W. 406 to the beginning corner, cont-
aining five acres, more or less.
