SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, D. B. Jackson, the said D. B. Jackson
in and by two certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Eight hundred sixty four and 6/100 dollars
Dollars, to be paid as therein stated

with interest thereon from the 21 day of June 1921 the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection or if said debt or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which are secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, D. B. Jackson, the said D. B. Jackson

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said R. L. Ford and J. T. Smith

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said D. B. Jackson

in hand well and truly paid by the said R. L. Ford and J. T. Smith

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said R. L. Ford and J. T. Smith.

All those two lots of land situate in the State and
County aforesaid near the town of Greer and de-
scribed as follows: Lot # 10 beginning at the corner of
lot # 6 on an unnamed street and runs thence N.
87.25 E. 215 feet to the corner of lot # 16; thence along
the line of this lot S. 13 1/2 W. 57 feet to the corner of lot
11; thence N. 87 W. 208 feet to said street; thence with
said street N. 16.20 E. 78 feet to the beginning corner Lot
11 Beginning at the corner of said unnamed street
and runs thence with the line of lot # 10 N. 87 W. 208
feet to the line of lot # 16; thence along the line of lot
16 S. 13 1/2 W. 57 feet to the corner of lot # 12; thence along
the line of this lot N. 81.30 W. 78 feet to the beginning
