Their heirs and assigns all that tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid near Paris Mountain and described as follows: Beginning at a stone just west of the road running out to the C.O. Allen place N. 68 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. four hundred ninety-five (495) feet to R. O. Stump; thence N. 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. six hundred seven (607) feet to 3 x 0 m thence S. 57 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 584 feet to stone thence S. 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 675 feet to sweet gum; thence S. 82 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 264 feet to a stone; thence S. 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 576 feet crossing the road to a stone; thence S. 67 W. less than 600 ft. to corner of Cole tract; thence S. 79 W. 349 feet to a stone; thence in a straight line, crossing the last mentioned road and the C.O.
