WHEREAS, J. N. M. Cannon, the said N. M. Cannon  
in and by a certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Eight hundred and forty Dollars,  
Dollars, to be paid as follows: \$100.00 statedly  
per month

with interest thereon from this date at the rate of seven per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose as mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per centum  
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That J. N. M. Cannon the said N. M. Cannon  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said J. A. Cannon

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said J. A. Cannon.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land  
situate lying and being in the State and County  
aforesaid and having the following description  
to-wit: - Being lots numbers 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 & 18,  
in block no. 2 of a sub-division of the J. A. Cannon  
property near Greer S.C. said sub-division being known  
as "Cannon's Park" according to plat of same made  
by H. G. Bagley, surveyor, in Nov. 1919. It is expressly  
agreed that this note and mortgage is given to  
secure a part of the purchase price of the  
above described property.
