lot # 9 on Conestee Avenue; running thence with Conestee Ave. N. 27.38
E. fifty feet to corner of lot # 7; thence N. 63.32 W. one hundred and
sixty-eight feet to alley; thence S. 27.58 with alley to corner of lot # 9; thence
S. 65.32 E. one hundred and sixty-eight feet and one inch to beginning
corner, being a part of the land conveyed to Cherokee Land Co. deed
recorded in deed book # 21, page 574, and made May 22, 1914 by
F. T. Dargaw, H. K. Lounes, J. R. Ware and L. O. Patterson, and was con-
veyed to me by said Cherokee Land Co. by deed dated Mar. 11th

running thence S. 9 1/2 W. sixty-six feet to an iron pin; thence running
about East sixty-one feet to an iron pin on a ten foot alley, thence
