SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, J. W. Wallace, the said J. W. Wallace,
in and by my (3) certain promissory note^{9/11} in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to
Jas. M. Richardson and H. B. Bates,
in the full and just sum of Three Thousand and twenty seven and 50/100 (3027.50)
Dollars, to be paid as follows: One note #403.66 due one year from date; one note
(#1,311.92) due 2-1/2 years from date; one note #1311.92 due 5 years from
date with the right to anticipate ^{any part thereof} payment of said payment.
with interest thereon from date at the rate of 6% per annum per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually.

.....until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose his mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of One (10%) per cent

.....besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceeding of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, That J. W. Wallace, the said J. W. Wallace,

in consideration of the said said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said J. W. Wallace,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said J. W. Wallace,

J. W. Wallace, in hand well and truly paid by the said Jas. M. Richardson and H. B. Bates,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said Jas. M. Richardson and H. B. Bates their heirs and

assigns forever:

All that certain piece parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in
the county and state aforesaid and in the City of Greenville on the west side
of Halls Street and being known and designated as lot no. 4 upon a plat
of the property of the said Jas. M. Richardson and H. B. Bates and being
described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Halls Street
and at corner of lot no. 3 and running thence along Halls Street N. 27.30
E. 23 feet and 8 inches to iron pin at corner of lot no. 3, thence along line
of lot no. 3 N. 62.30 W. 82 feet and 3 inches to an iron pin at a 10'-
foot alley and at corner of lot no. 3, thence along said alley S. 27.30 W.
23 feet and 8 inches to an iron pin at corner of lot no. 5, thence along
line of lot no. 5 S. 62.30 E. 82 feet and 3 inches to the beginning corner
and being the same lot conveyed to me by the said Jas. M. Richardson
and H. B. Bates, by their deed of even date herewith.
