as the day of July, 1921, and to be paid to the Bank of Greenville, S.C.

with interest thereon from the maturity date of this note at the rate of Eight per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi annually,

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due shall bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten percent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Bank of Greenville, S.C.

All that lot of land in Chick Spangs Township, state and county aforesaid just outside of the city limits of the town of Greenville being known as lot no. 9 on a plat by W. L. Pearce, Engineer, in April 1912, having the following vertices and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on James Street (N. M. Cannon's corner) and runs thence N. 7-15 E. 10-2-5 feet to an iron pin (Cannon and Bobo corner) thence S. 82-15 E. 5-2 feet to an iron pin, thence east to an iron pin on James Street, thence N. 83-30 W. 5-2 feet with James Street to the beginning corner, being the same tract of land conveyed to me by N. M. Cannon, Feb. 23<sup>rd</sup> 1919.

Also all that piece, parcel and lot of land in Greenville Township, state and county aforesaid west of the City of Greenville and west of the Overhead Bridge on Hampton Avenue extension crossing the Southern Railway, having the following vertices and bounds to wit

Beginning at an iron pin on a 80 foot street at the point 100 feet southwest of the corner of St. Clair St. and Hampton Avenue which is the common corner of land formerly owned by Theron Earle and G. L.
