promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any
kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *The* *Lucy L. Hindman and Leon Gillespie* the said *Lucy L. Hindman and Leon Gillespie*
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better
securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me
in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Sarah R. Davidson, her heirs*
and assigns forever
all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in
Township, Greenville County, *3rd* of South Carolina,

Those two certain tracts of land described as follows.
Tract no. 1: Containing 111 3/4 acres, more or less, adjoining lands of Brown Estate, Howard, and others, being the same tract of land conveyed to us by W. D. Parrish and J. C. Sower by deed dated May 7th, 1919, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Vol. 50 page 314.
Tract no. 2: Containing 32 2/10 acres, more or less, about 4 1/2 miles southeast of the City of Greenville, being lot no. 4 in the division of the real estate of Jackson Brown, deceased, in a plat made by W. A. Adams, adjoining lands of Perry Hudson and others. Being the same tract of land conveyed to us by J. T. Jones, by deed dated the day of January 1920.
