All that certain lot in South Carolina, Greenville County, Greenville Township on the West side of Spartanburg road and east of the City of Greenville beginning at the corner of Watkins lot (lot purchased by Watkins from Datek) and running thence with said Watkins line north 40.37 west three hundred twenty-seven (327) feet, thence south 81.38 west twenty-five (25) feet, thence in a southerly direction to a point on the Spartanburg road one hundred (100) feet distant from said Watkins corner mentioned, thence with said Spartanburg road 77.69.07 E. one hundred (100) feet to the beginning corner said lot being of a triangular shape with a frontage on said Spartanburg road of one hundred (100) feet and of a width in the rear line of twenty-five (25) feet and adjoining the present homestead of the said P. R. Watkins being the same lot of land conveyed to Amie L. Walker by T. R.
