NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Lura W. Stone, in consideration of the said debt above mentioned, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Farmers Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of one further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said,

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Farmers Loan and Trust Company,

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in Ward One of the city of Greenville on the north side of Stone Avenue and having the following metes & bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake on the north side of Stone Avenue 149 feet 6 inches from the north-west corner of Robinson Street and Stone Avenue and running thence N. 42-24 E. one hundred ninety-six feet to a stake on back line of lot no. 1; thence with the back line of lot no. 1; thence with the back line of lot no. 1 in a westerly direction sixty feet to a stake; thence S. 42-24 W. about one hundred nine feet to a stake on the north side of Stone Avenue; thence with Stone Avenue S. 83-13 W. Sixty feet to the beginning corner and being the eastern portion of lot no. 2 of Sect. "D" of a revised plat of Stone Land Company, and being one of the lots formerly belonging to the Stone Land Company. Also, all that other piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid in Ward Five of the city of Greenville on the south side of Dunbar Street, and being lot no. 8 of a plat recorded in R. M. C. Office in Plat Book "A" Page 163, Said lot having a frontage on Dunbar Street of fifty feet with a depth of two hundred fifteen feet and being the same lot of land purchased by me from J. C.
