with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be computed and paid monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of five percent of whole amount due thereon

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated; lying and being in Saluda Township, County and State aforesaid on Terry or Beaver Dam Creek, waters of North Fork Saluda River, Containing 221 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake J.
