thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being

bargain, sell and release unto the said W.M. Henson, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land

situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid in Chick Springs Township and
on the east side of the Greer-Gibbs Shoals Road, and having the following metes and
bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at a stone on the East side of Greer-Gibbs Shoal Road, Hammond's corner, and
running thence with his line S. 50 E. 455 feet to a stake; thence S. 53 W. 752.4 feet to
a stone; thence N. 54 W. 114 feet to center of said road; thence with said road N. 29- $\frac{1}{2}$
E. 600 feet to a bend in said road; thence N. 23- $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 169 feet to the beginning corner,
