Taylor and W.W. Burgess, beginning at a stake in center of National Highway, J.D. Ashmore's corner, running thence N. 19.30 E. 94 feet to bend in road, thence N. 61 E. 131 feet to bend in road, thence N. 30 E. 441 feet to a stake in road, thence N. 11.30 E. 173 feet to a stake, thence N. 0, 30 E. 220 feet to a corner of J.P. Taylor's land thence with his line, S. 79.20 E. 339 feet, to a stone Burgess's corner thence with Burgess' line S. 33 W. 466 feet to a stake, thence S. 56.45 E. 261 feet to a stake, thence S. 35 W. 754 feet to a stake in center of National Highway, thence with said Highway N. 33.45 W. 363 feet to a stake in road, thence N. 47.35 W. 65 feet to the beginning corner, being lots nos. 2, 3 & 4 as shown on a plat-division surveyed for C.L.
