A certain tract or parcel of land situate in Glassey Mountain Township, County and State aforesaid, deeded to me by Mrs Laura A. Parker on the 16th day of December 1919, having the following metes and bounds, on branch waters of Jamison's Mill Creek, Waters of South Pacolet, Beginning on a double post-oak bush 3x, running thence N. 15 2/3 70 poles to a poplar 3x, N. 14 1/4 East 80 poles to a Spanish oak 3x thence N. 29 East three poles to a hickory; thence N. 68 poles to a Sourwood; thence with N. E. Lockart's and James Watson's line or corner; thence with N. E. Lockart's Earl land and Turner land to a chestnut, gone, now a stone 3x below the Oak Grove Baptist Church, running thence with the Church and Grave Yard lot to Oak Grove Road, running thence about West with said road to the beginning corner, containing forty seven (47) acres, more or less, adjoining lands of H. W. Plumley, N. E. Lockart and others. There is excepted from the above boundaries about four acres hereto fore conveyed by Mrs Laura A. Parker to Mrs. Holt for school purposes, there being conveyed by this conveyance forty seven acres, more or less.
